HomeWorks Trenton is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides a [community-based after-school, residential program](#) that provides academic and social-emotional enrichment activities to supplement public schools, empower women, and build community leaders.

Dates for Full-Year Program

During School Year: September 2020 - June 2021

- Sunday Night - Friday Morning (At HomeWorks: *Boarding Required*)
- Friday Morning - Sunday Night (*Students return home to families*)
- Parents/Families: Mandatory Potluck Dinners on Sunday Nights 2x/month
- Student Orientation: August TBD
- Parent Orientation: August TBD
- Parents/Families: Mandatory parent conferences 2x in both Fall (October TBD, December TBD) and Spring semester (March TBD, June TBD)

What do we mean by "after-school residential program"?

Our students attend their public schools during the day, then stay with us overnight in a dorm and participate in after-school activities, eat a warm meal, and build lifelong bond with their peers. Residential schools are expensive and rarely accessible to most students, but they come with many benefits: low student-teacher ratio, tight knit community, and group maturity. We are unique because we supplement—not replace—the Trenton public school system. HomeWorks offers a local solution to a local challenge.
